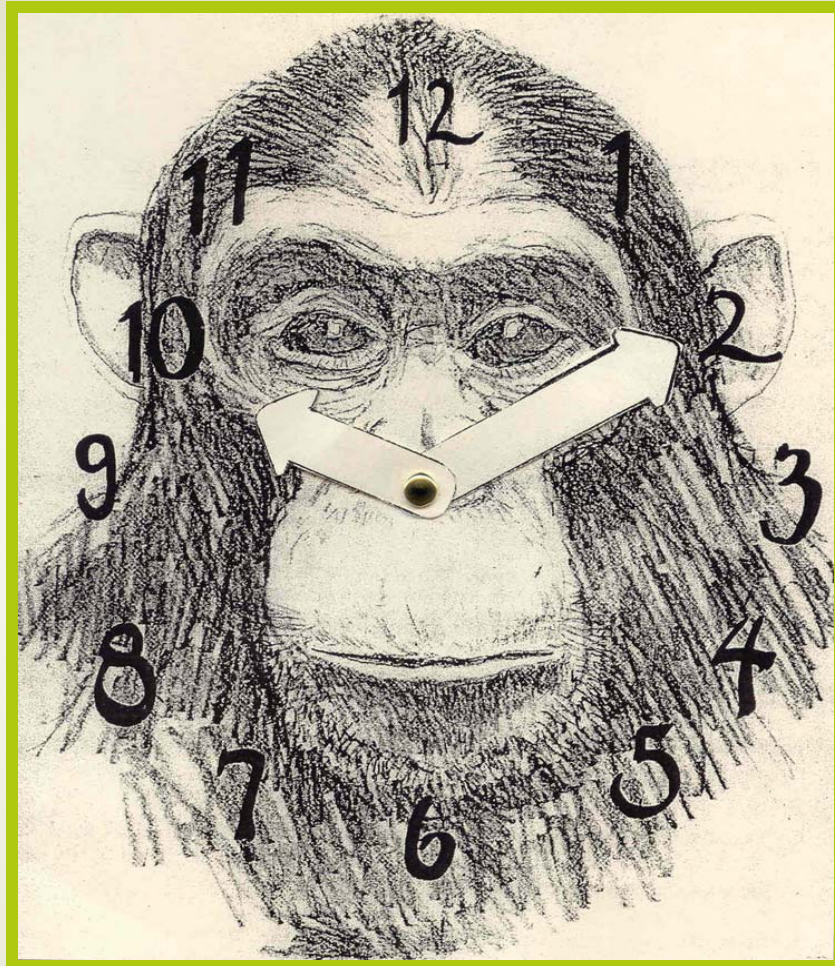

### **Chimpanzee Clock**

Have fun creating and decorating your own chimpanzee clock. Learn to tell time on the chimpanzee clock by moving the hands to different positions.

#### **Materials needed:**

1. Drawing of a chimpanzee's face on a clock along with the clock hands
2. 1 sheet of 8 ½ x 11 cardstock of your choice of color
3. Child-safe Scissors
4. Brass fastener
5. Crayons or color pencils to decorate the chimpanzee clock
6. A pencil or pen



### Steps to create this activity:

1. Photocopy the chimpanzee clock and clock hands on your choice color of card stock.
2. The chimpanzee face clock can be colored and decorated using crayons or color pencils before beginning the step below.
3. Cut along the dotted line at the bottom of the chimpanzee face clock.
4. Cut out the clock hands along the dotted lines.
5. Use a pencil or pen to make small openings in three areas:
  - The middle of the chimpanzee face clock
  - The end of the short clock hand
  - The end of the tall clock handA small dark circle will mark these areas.
6. Take the brass fastener and insert it into the opening of the tall clock hand, then insert the brass fastener into the opening of the short clock hand and finally insert the brass fastener into the opening on the chimpanzee face clock.
7. Turn your chimpanzee face clock over and spread the clamps of the brass fastener out flat to hold the clock hands in place. Use crayons or color pencils to decorate your clock.
8. Your clock is now complete. Look at a clock or watch nearby and set the time on your chimpanzee face clock. It's playtime!
